#### 210    **Introduction to Forensic Science**

Fall. 3(3-0) Interdepartmental with Criminal Justice. Administered by Criminal Justice. RB: A background in general chemistry and biology.

Techniques of crime scene search. Collection and preservation of physical evidence. Class and individual scientific tests. Rules of evidence governing admissibility of physical evidence. Expert testimony.

#### 809    **Issues in Forensic Science**

Fall, Spring. 2 to 4 credits. A student may earn a maximum of 12 credits in all enrollments for this course. R: Open only to graduate students in the Forensic Science major.

Forensic science research, practice, and legal processes.

#### 890    **Independent Study**

Fall, Spring, Summer. 1 to 6 credits. A student may earn a maximum of 6 credits in all enrollments for this course. R: Open only to graduate students in the Forensic Science major.

Individual research and writing under faculty supervision.

#### 894    **Practicum**

Fall, Spring, Summer. 1 to 6 credits. A student may earn a maximum of 6 credits in all enrollments for this course. R: Open only to graduate students in the Forensic Science major.

Observation, study, and work in selected forensic science agencies.

#### 899    **Master's Thesis Research**

Fall, Spring, Summer. 1 to 6 credits. A student may earn a maximum of 12 credits in all enrollments for this course.

Planned research and writing directed by student's thesis committee.
