Attached is the complete enrollment report for the fall term of 1959. The table below shows the distribution of student enrollments for the fall terms of 1958 and 1959. This includes all students enrolled irrespective of the number of credits carried.

We notice that there is a 17.8 percent increase in new transfer students and a 26.9 percent increase in new first-time students (freshmen). We also notice a 22.6 percent increase in new graduate students while the overall graduate enrollment increased 5.5 percent.

The increase in enrollment this fall over a year ago is 6.29 percent or 3.5 percent exclusive of Michigan State University-Oakland.
