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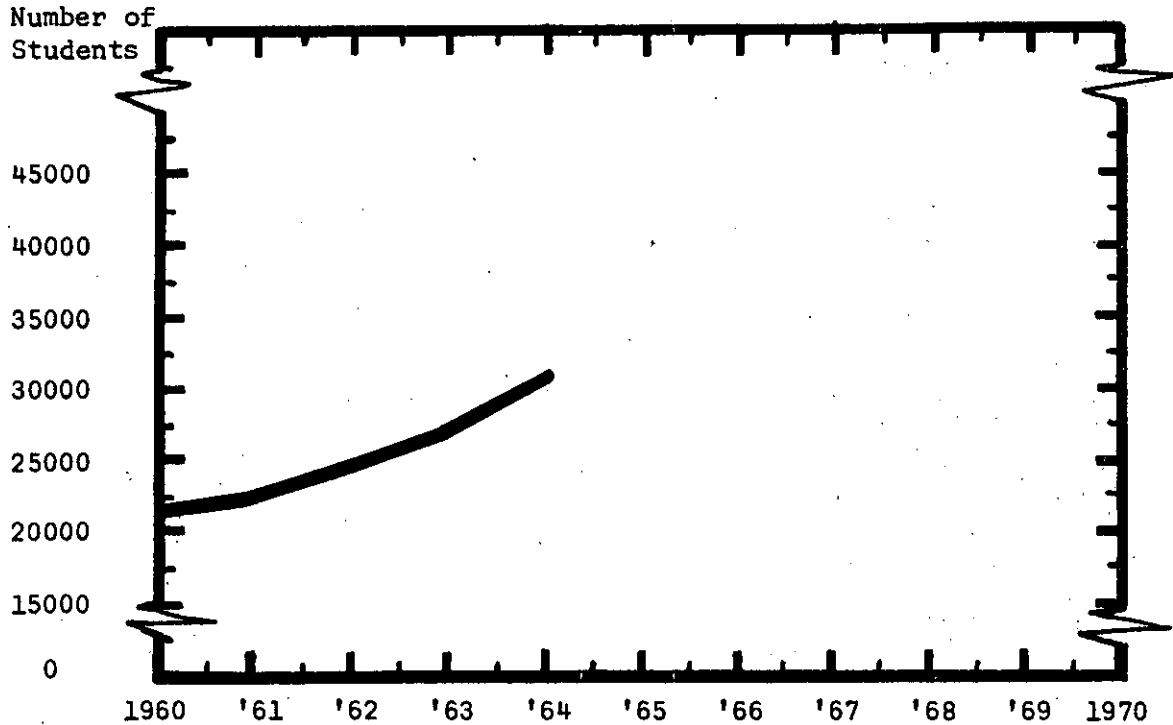

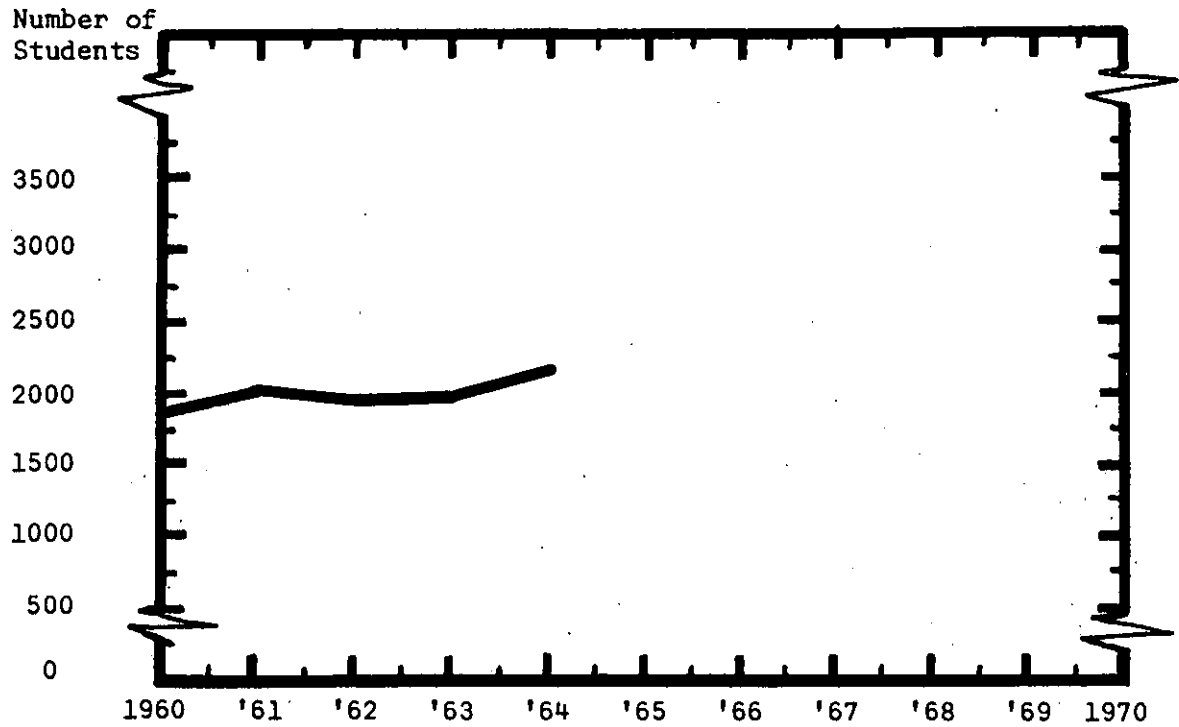

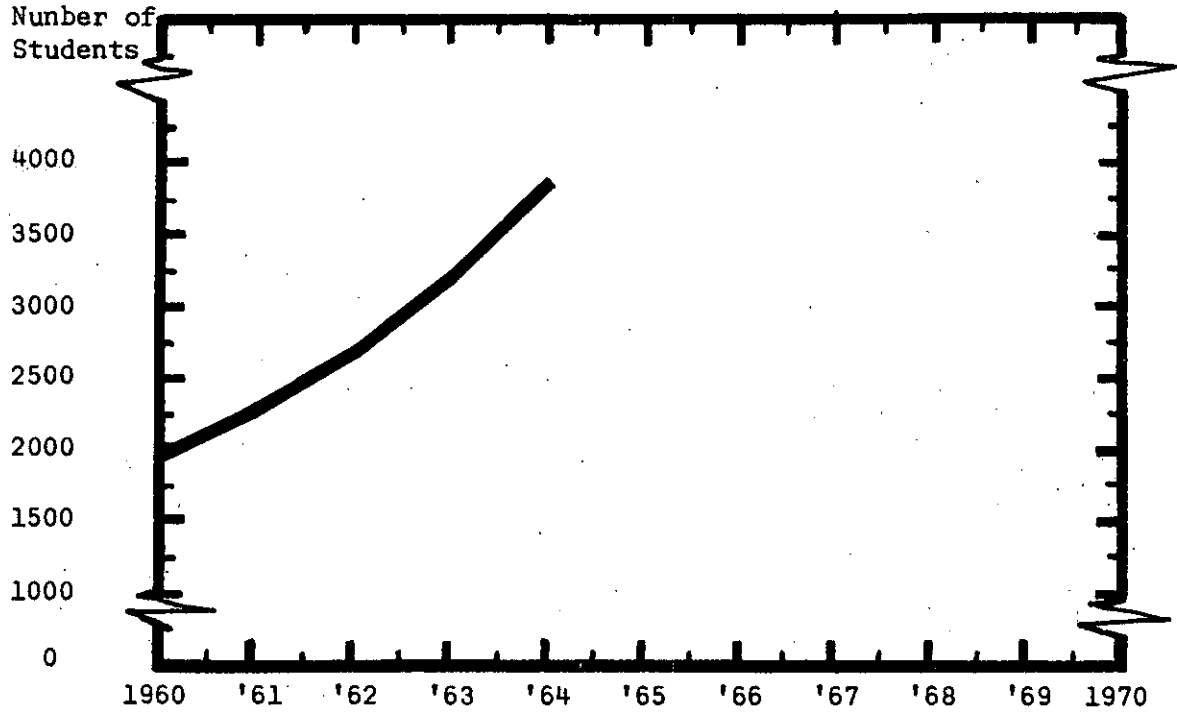

COMPARISON OF FALL TERM ENROLLMENTS

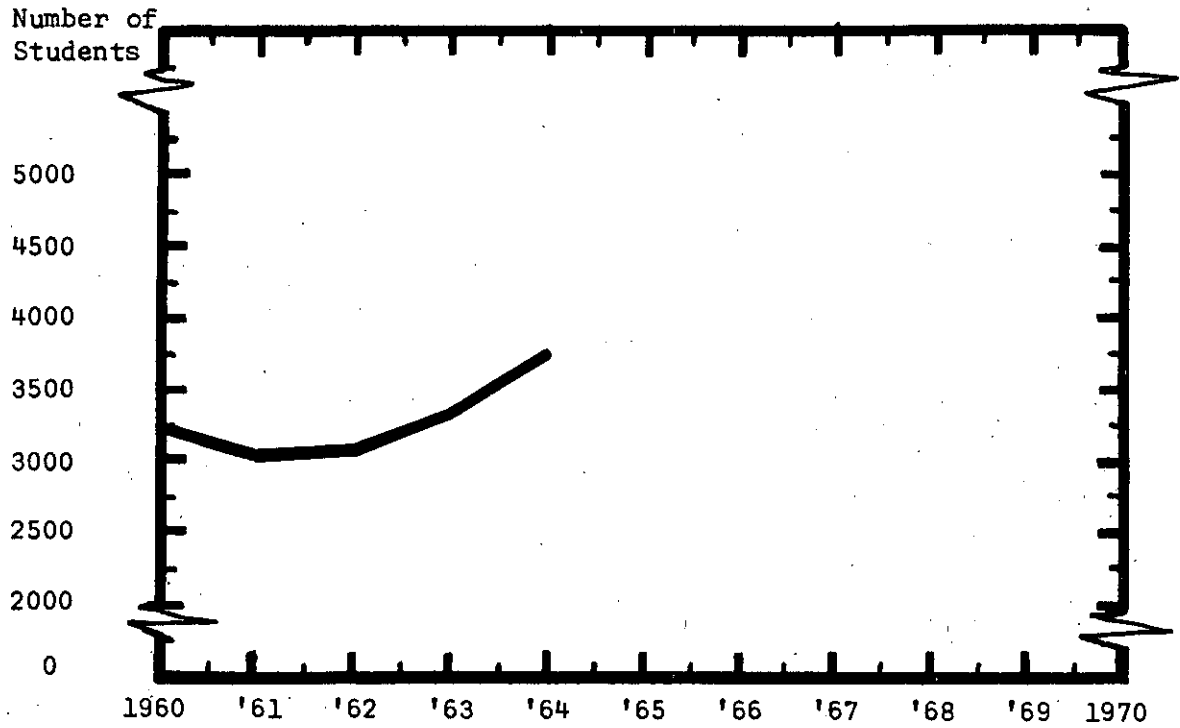

COMPARISON OF FALL TERM ENROLLMENTS



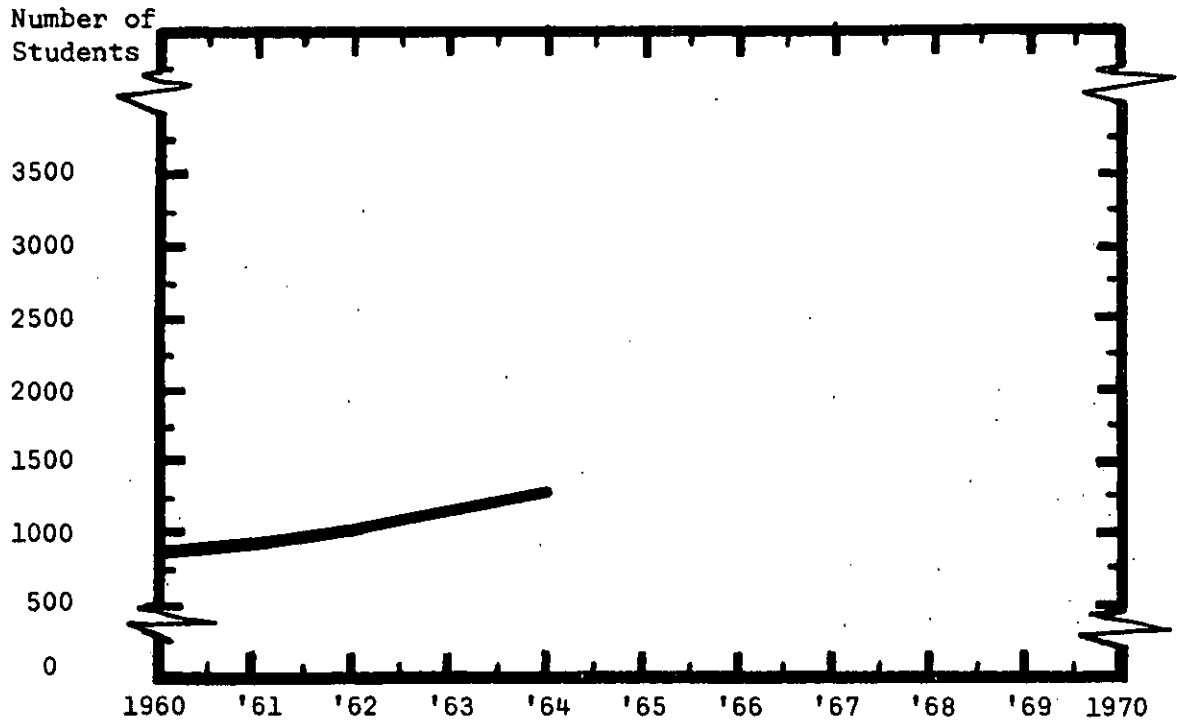

COMPARISON OF FALL TERM ENROLLMENTS



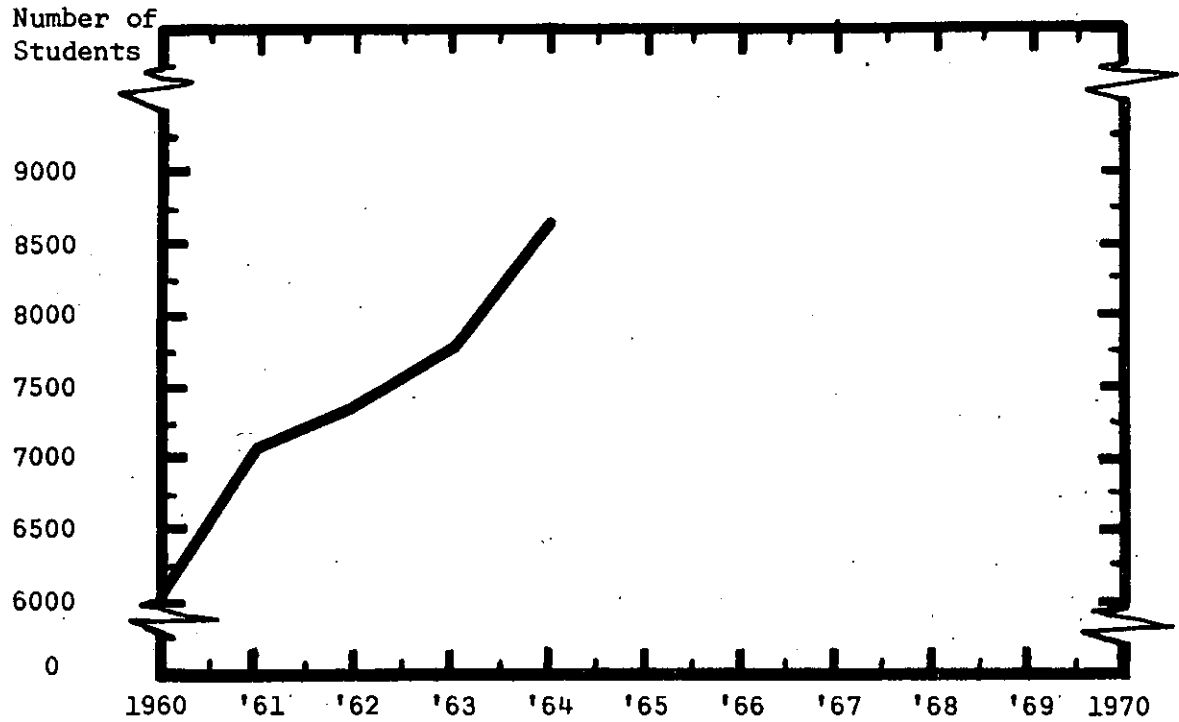

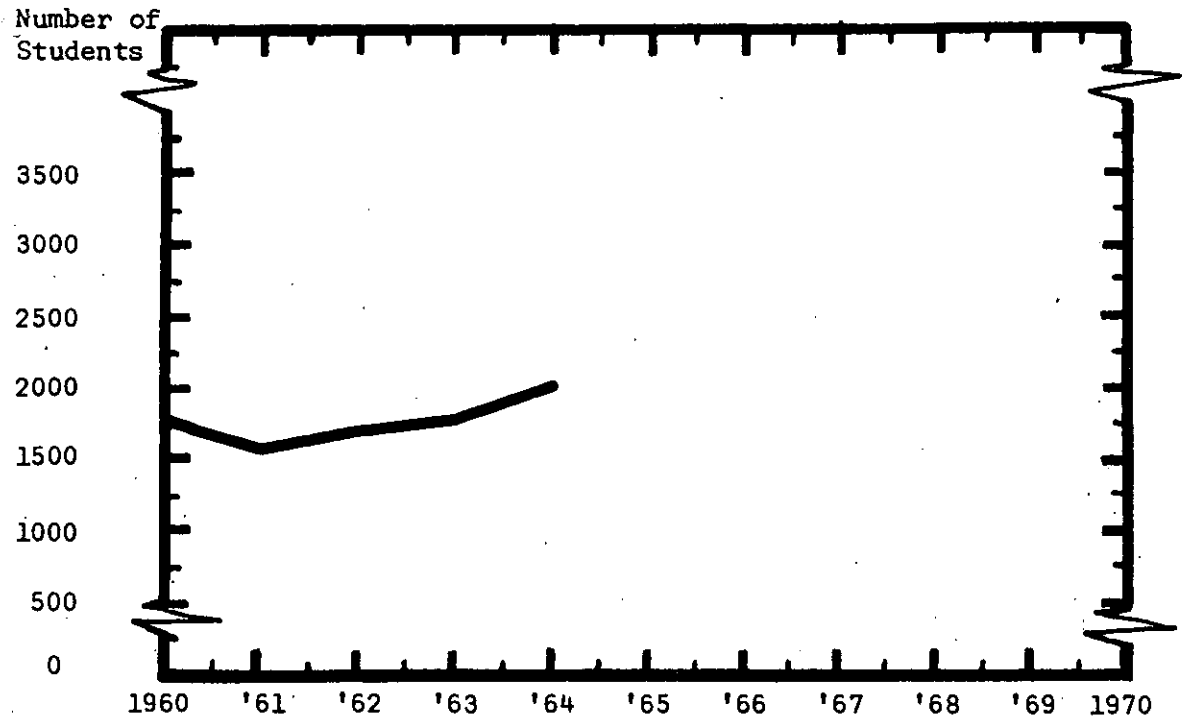

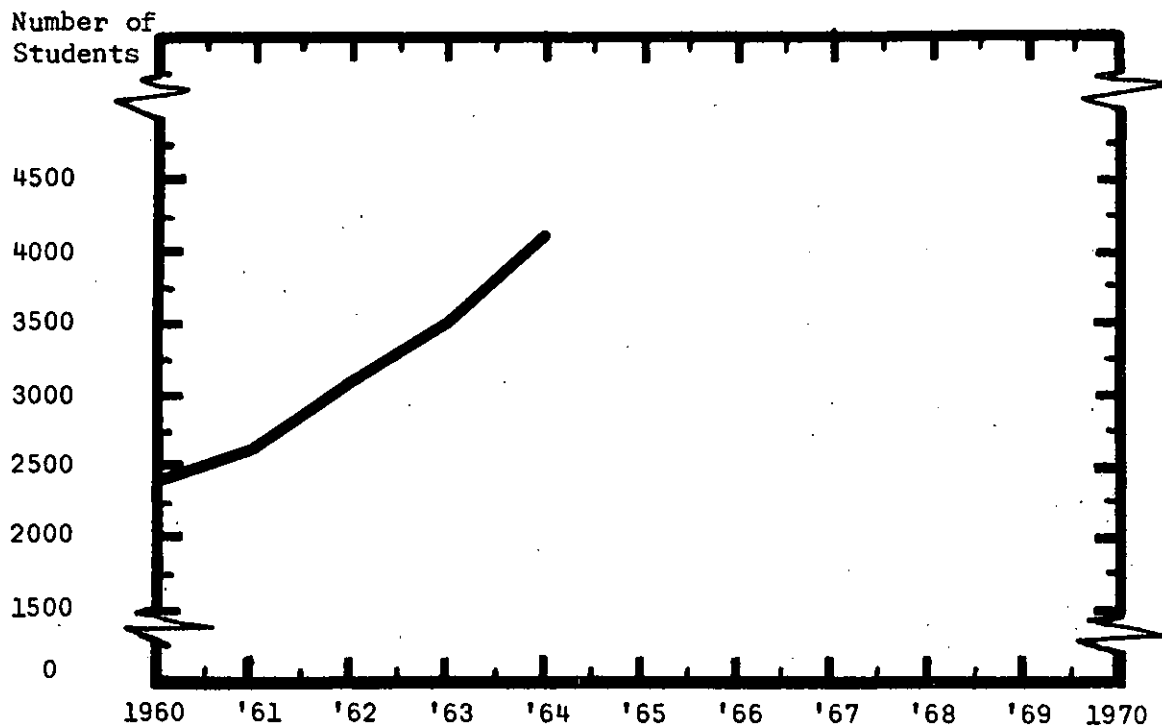

COMPARISON OF FALL TERM ENROLLMENTS



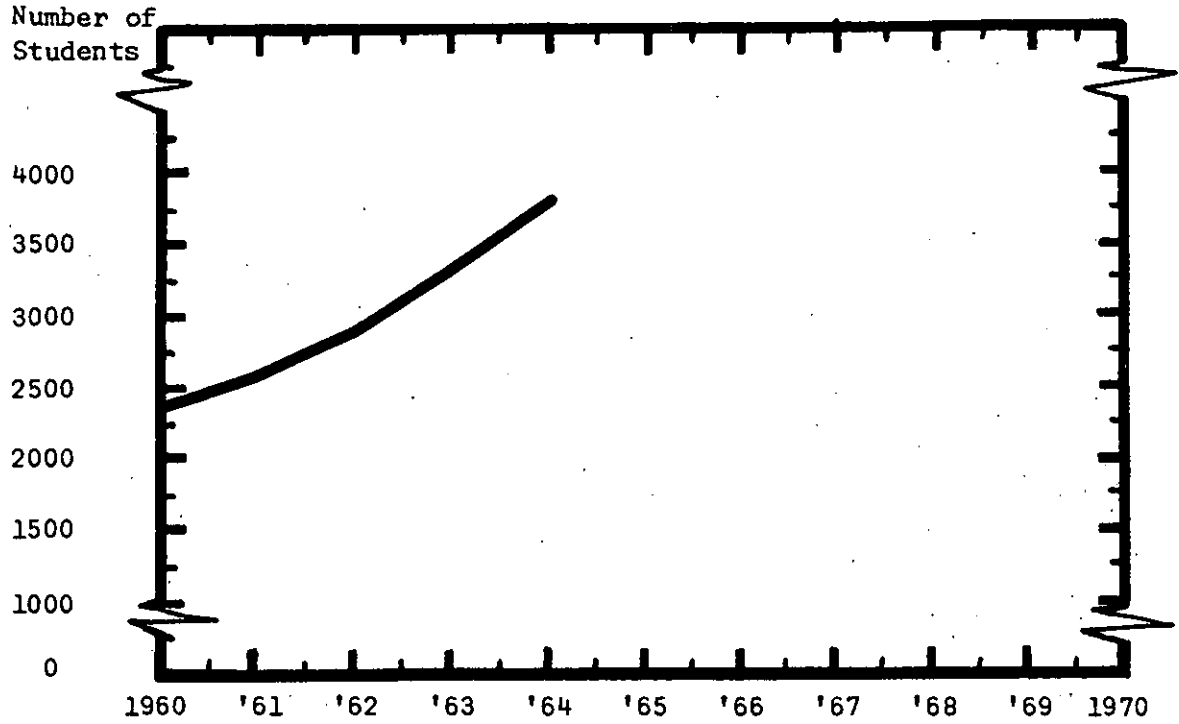

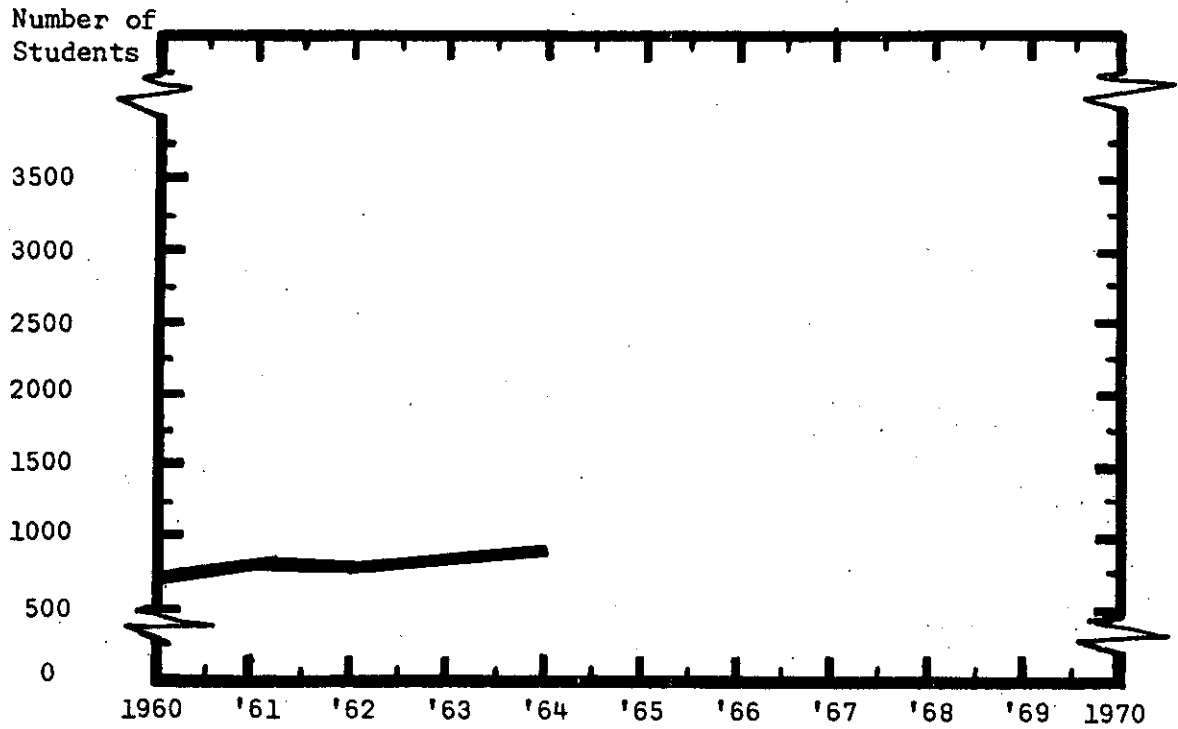

COMPARISON OF FALL TERM ENROLLMENTS



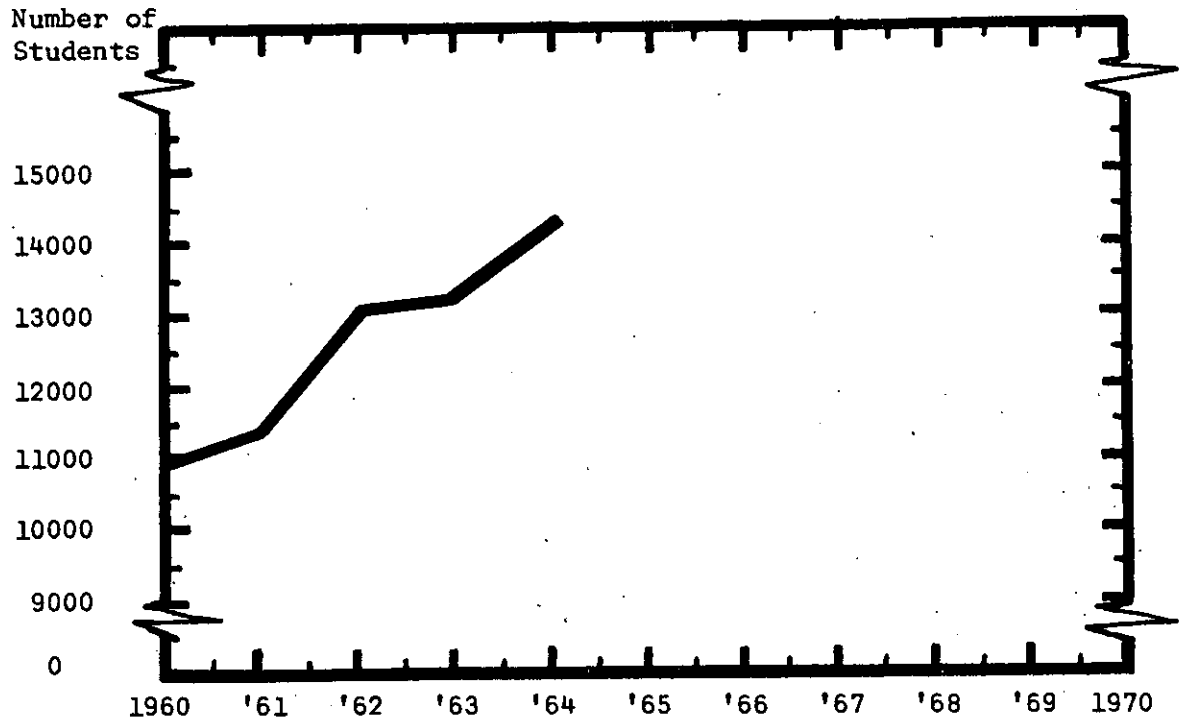
