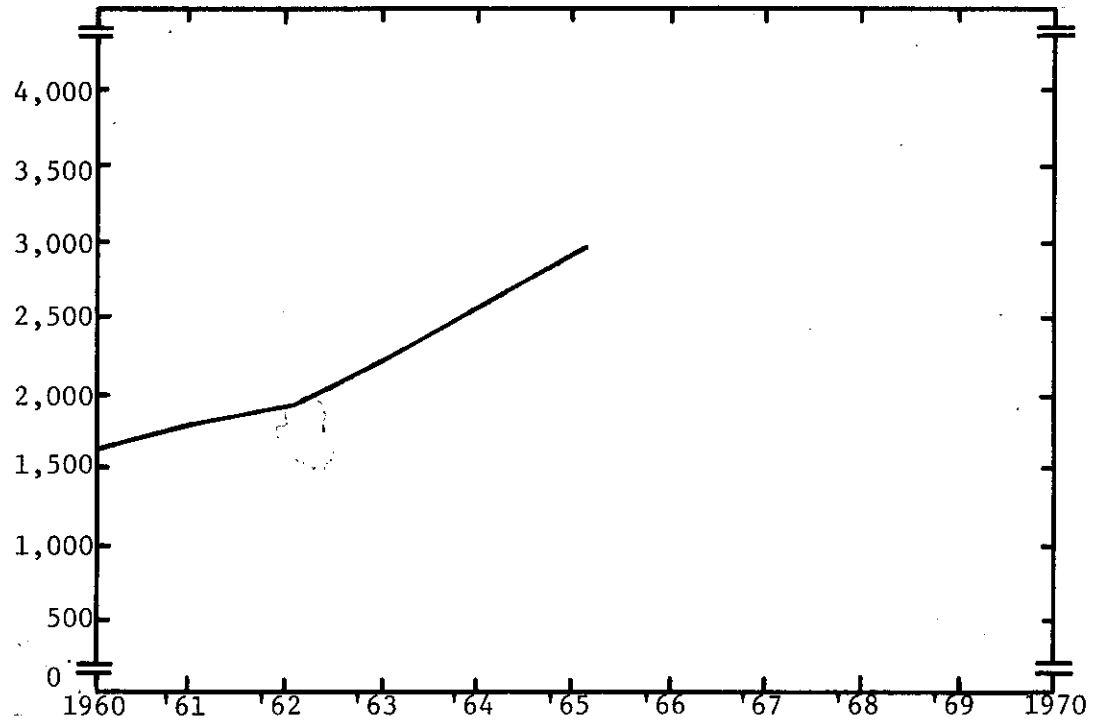

Summer & Fall Terms



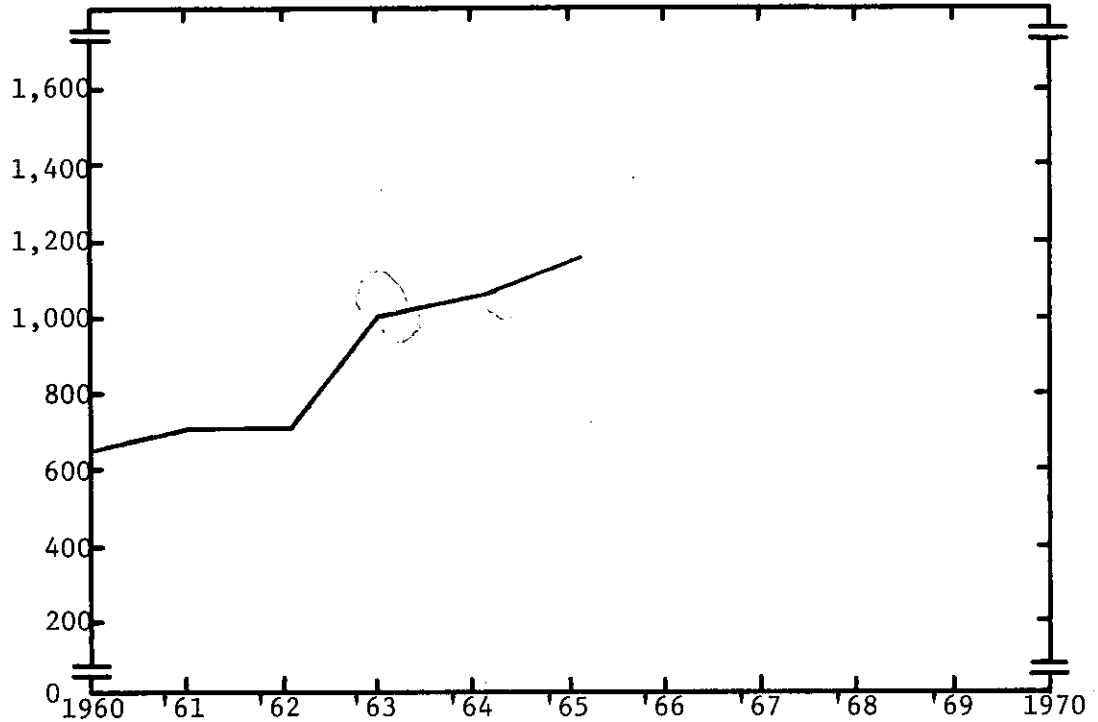
