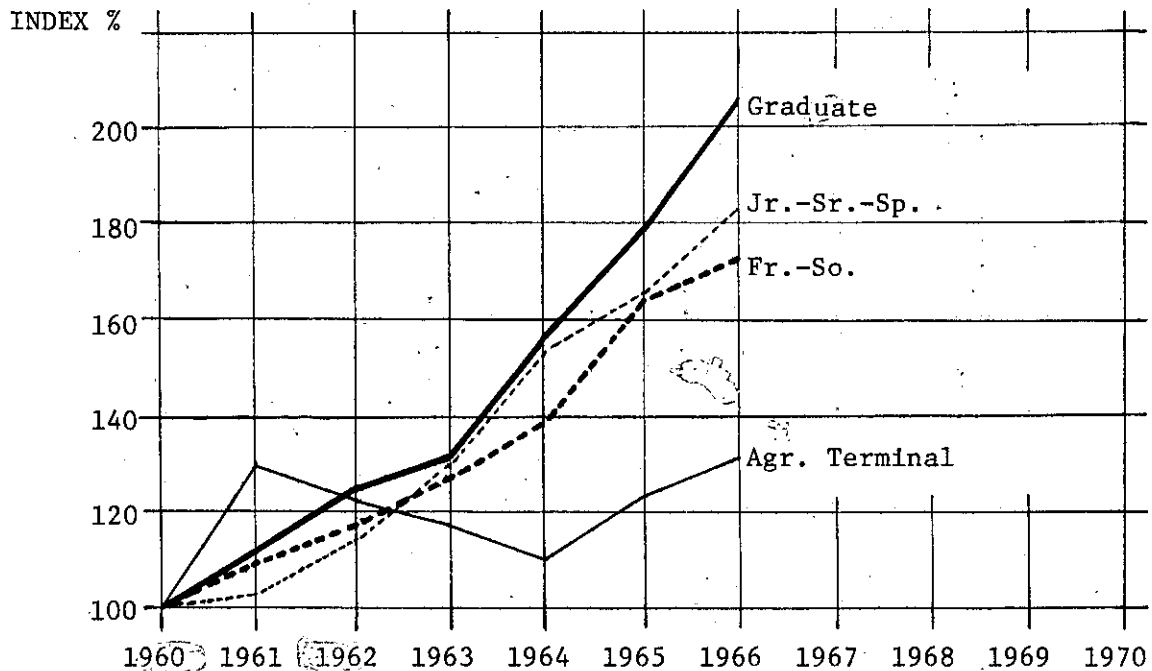

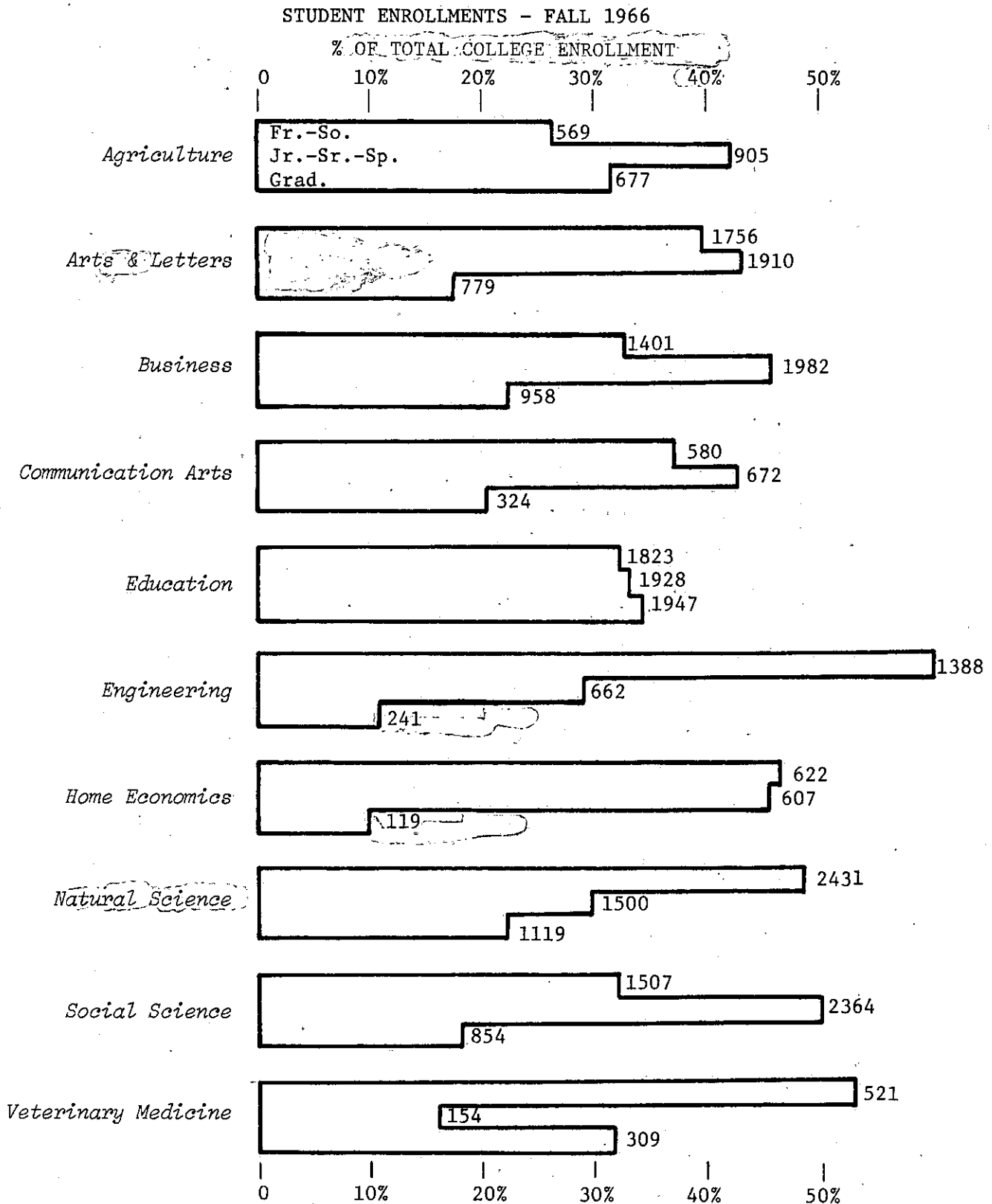
GROWTH PATTERNS OF THE
