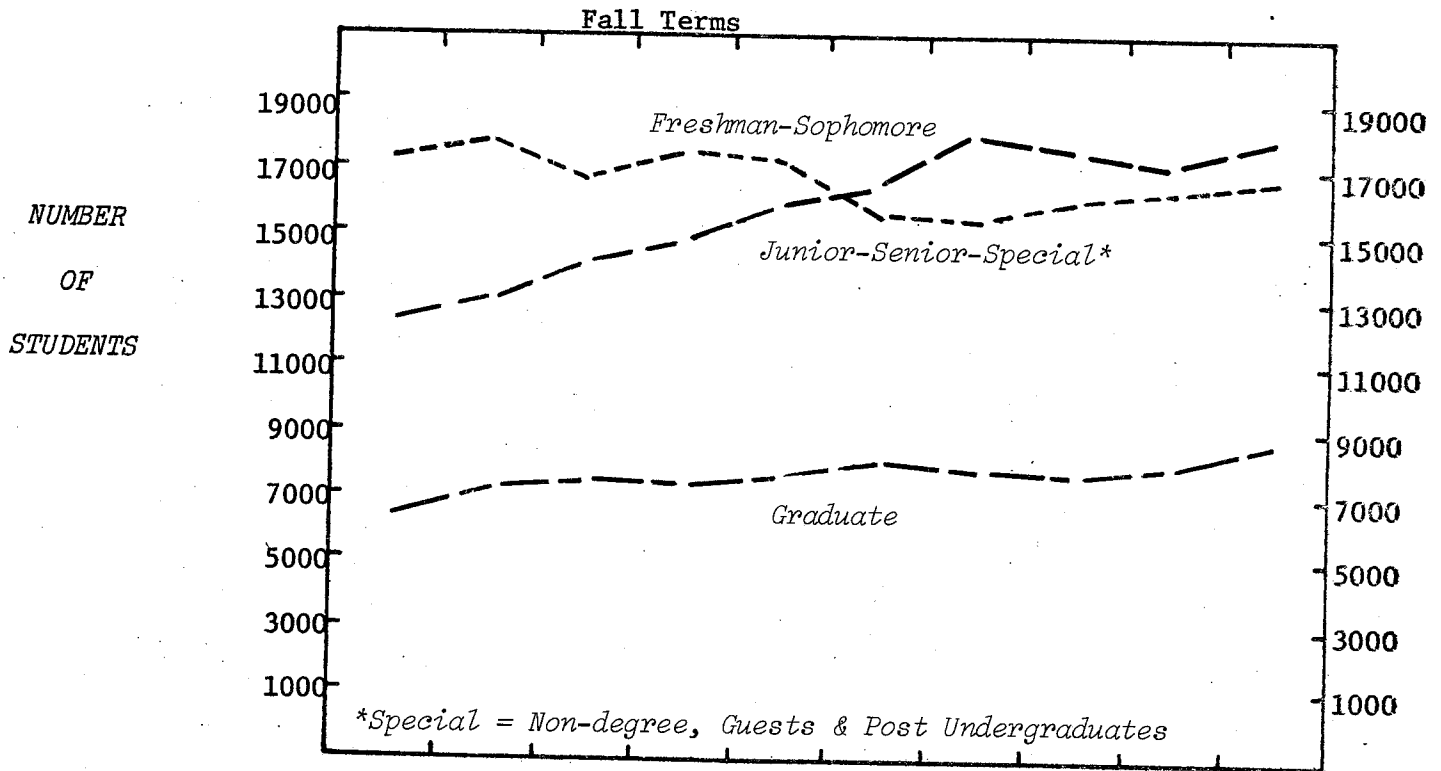

East Lansing Campus



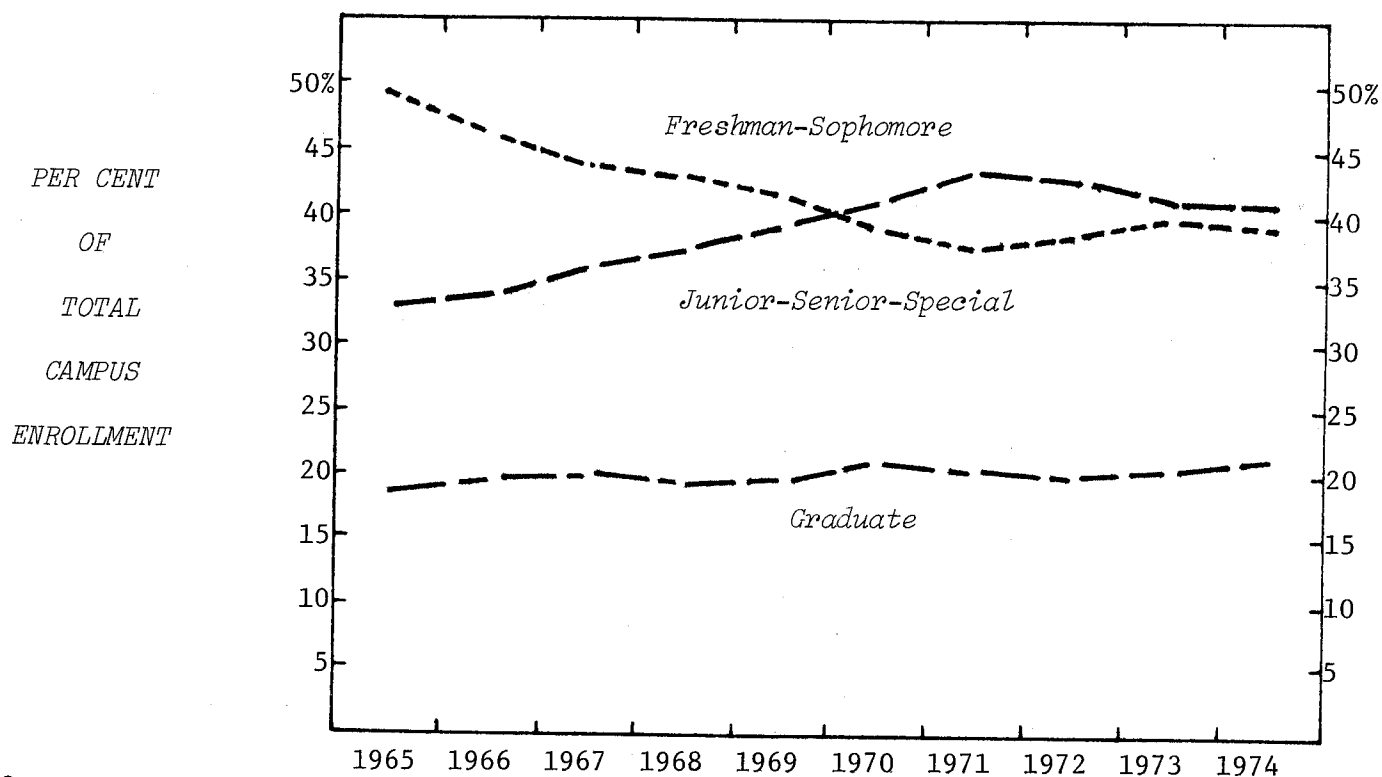
