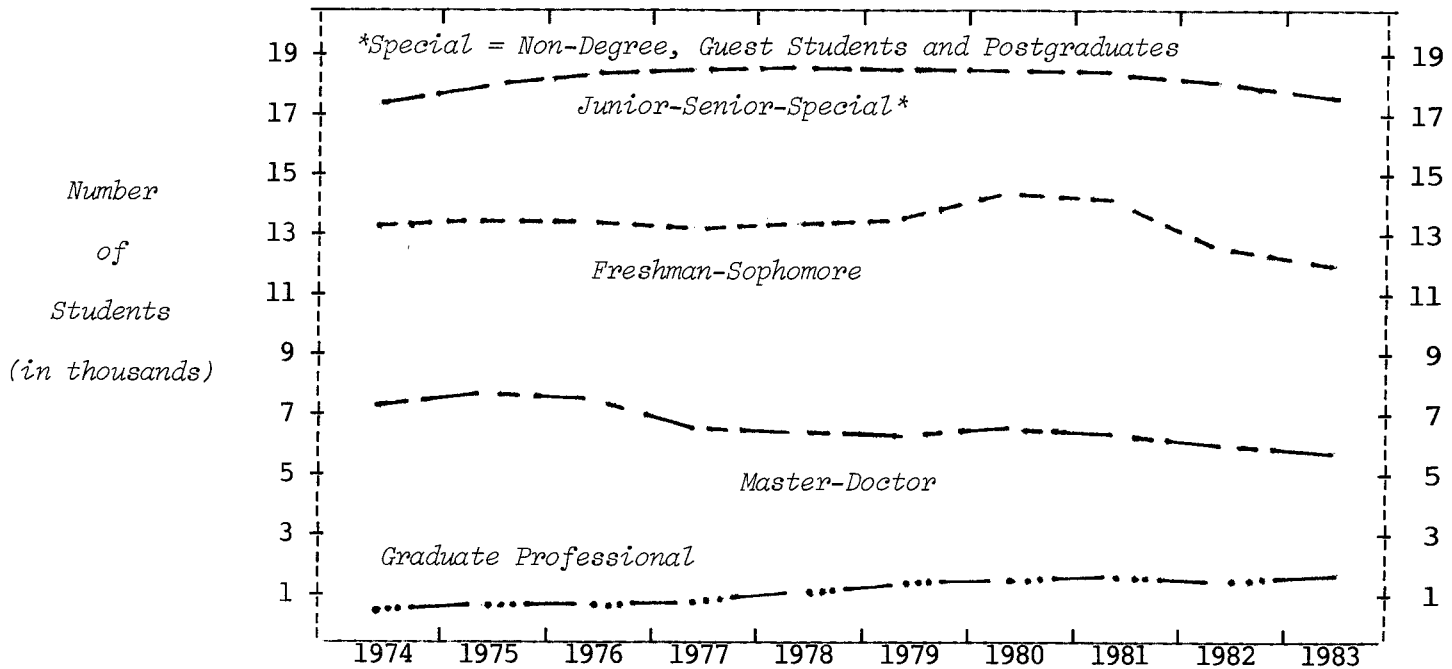

Spring Terms



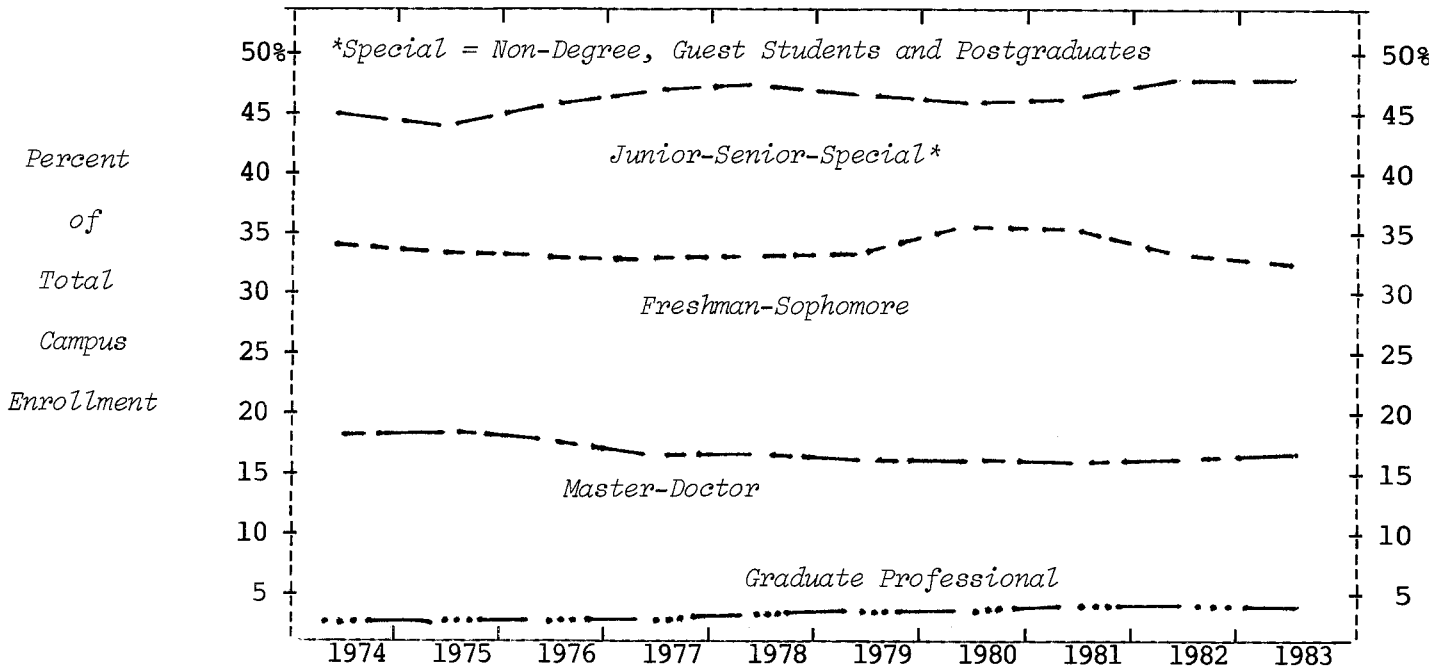

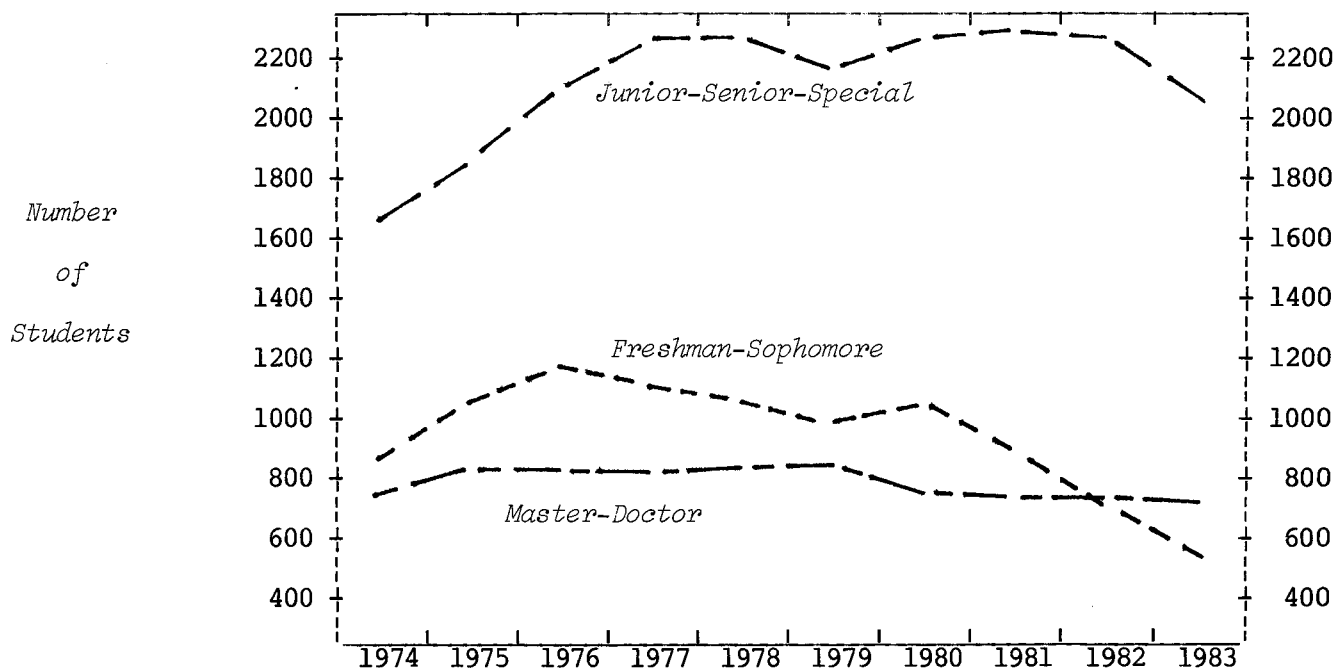

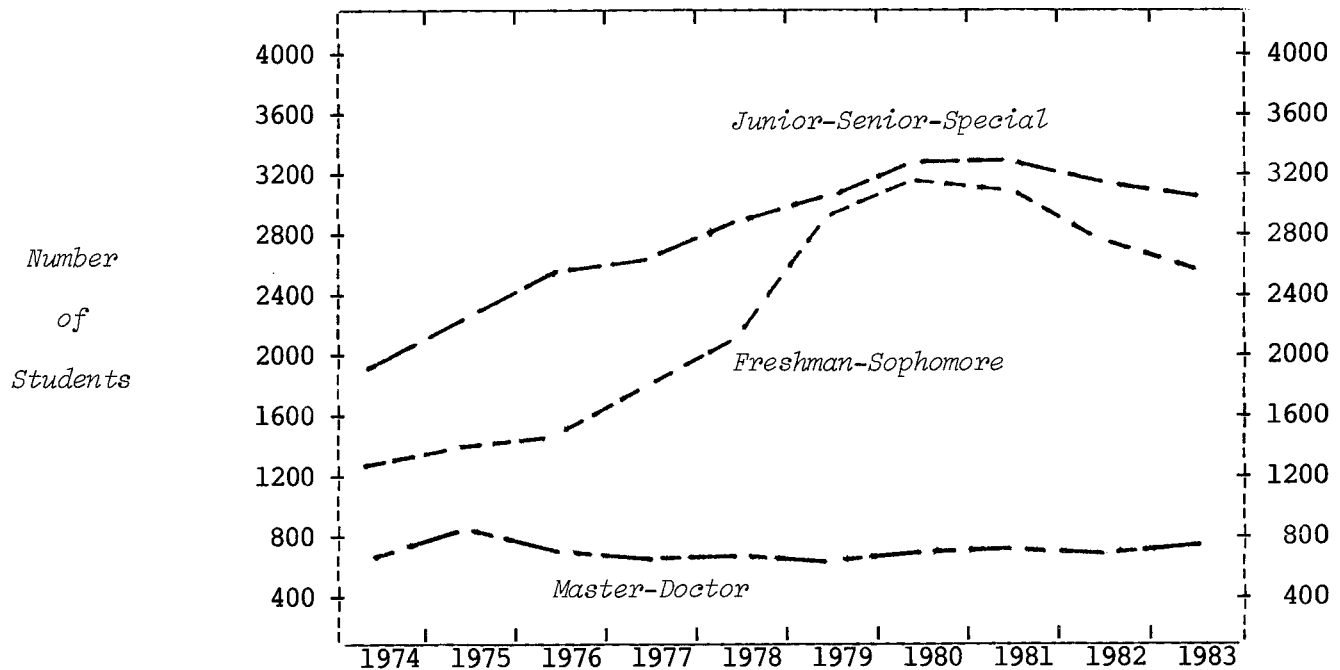
