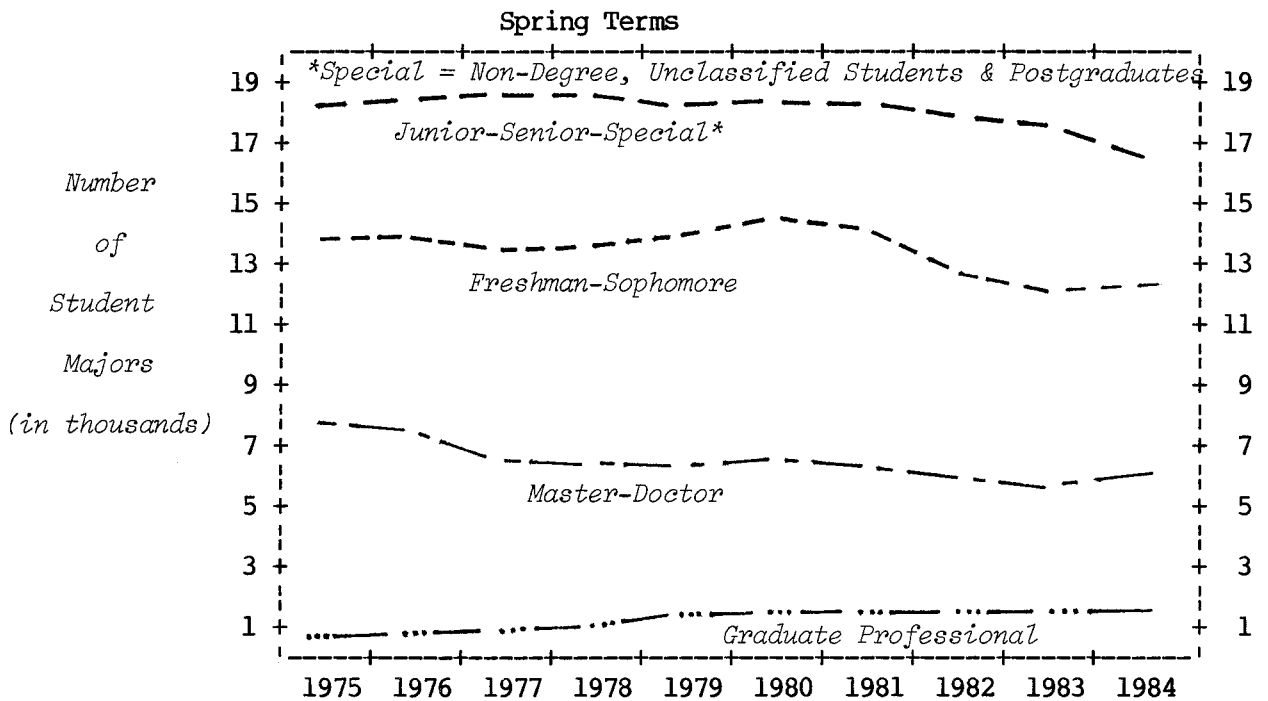

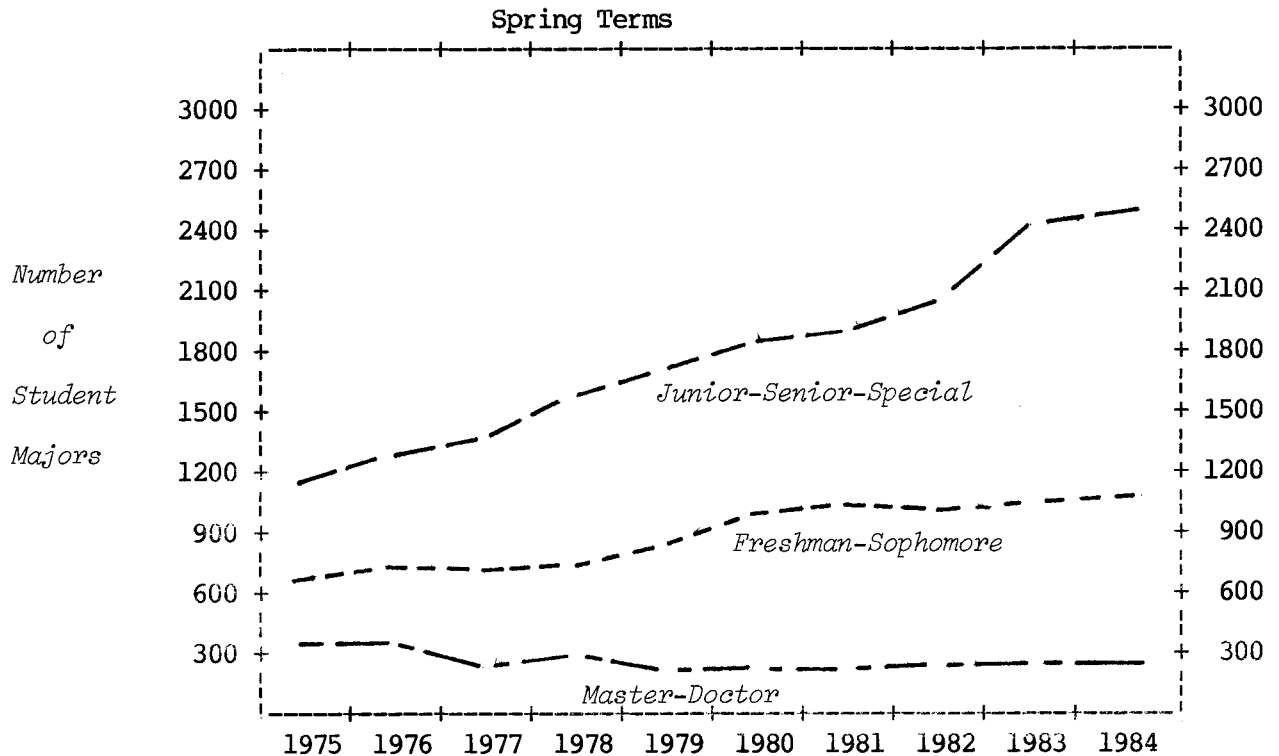

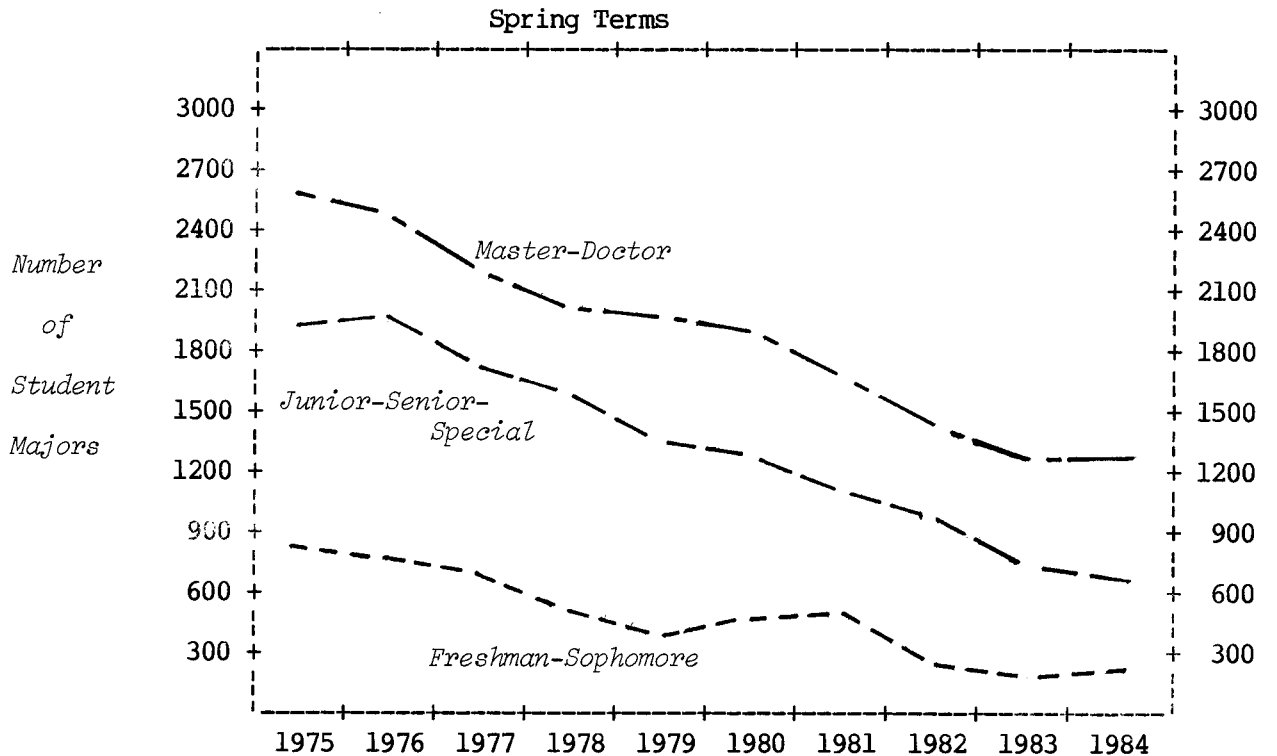
Trendgraph of Term Enrollments by Level

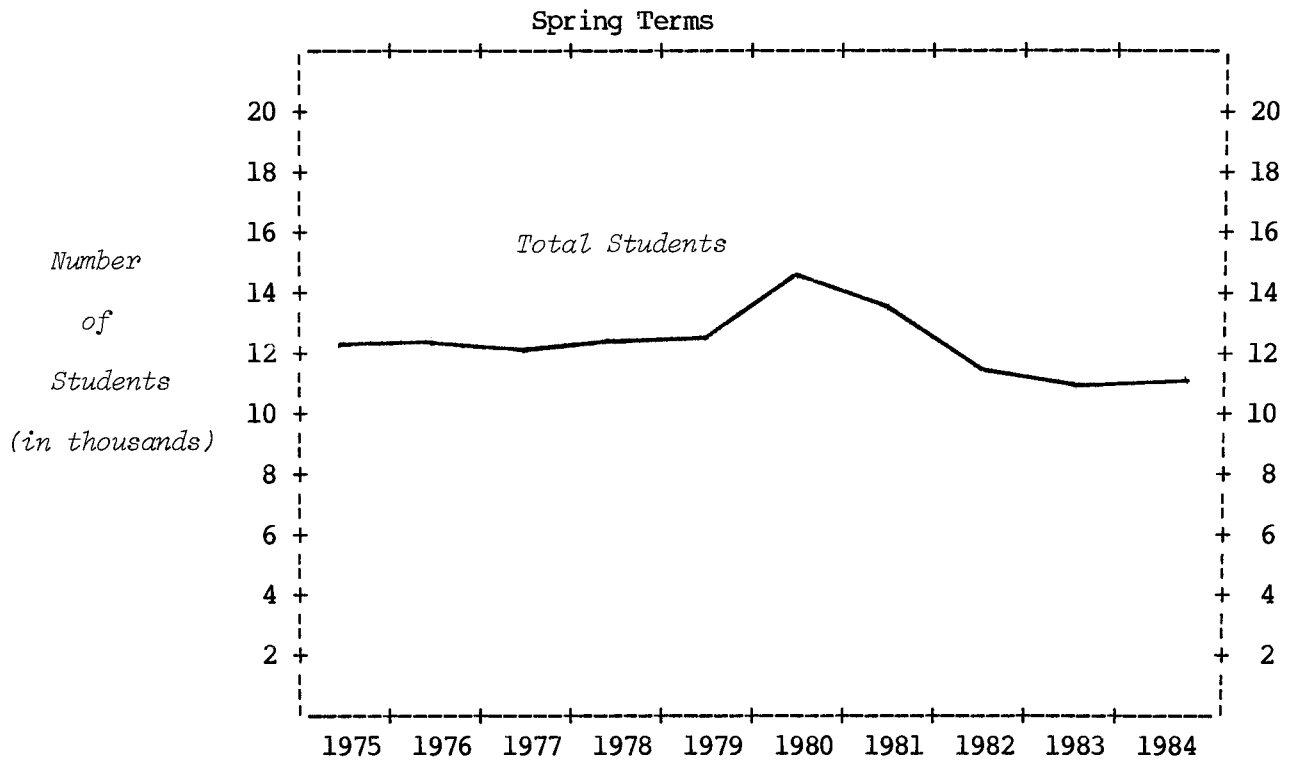

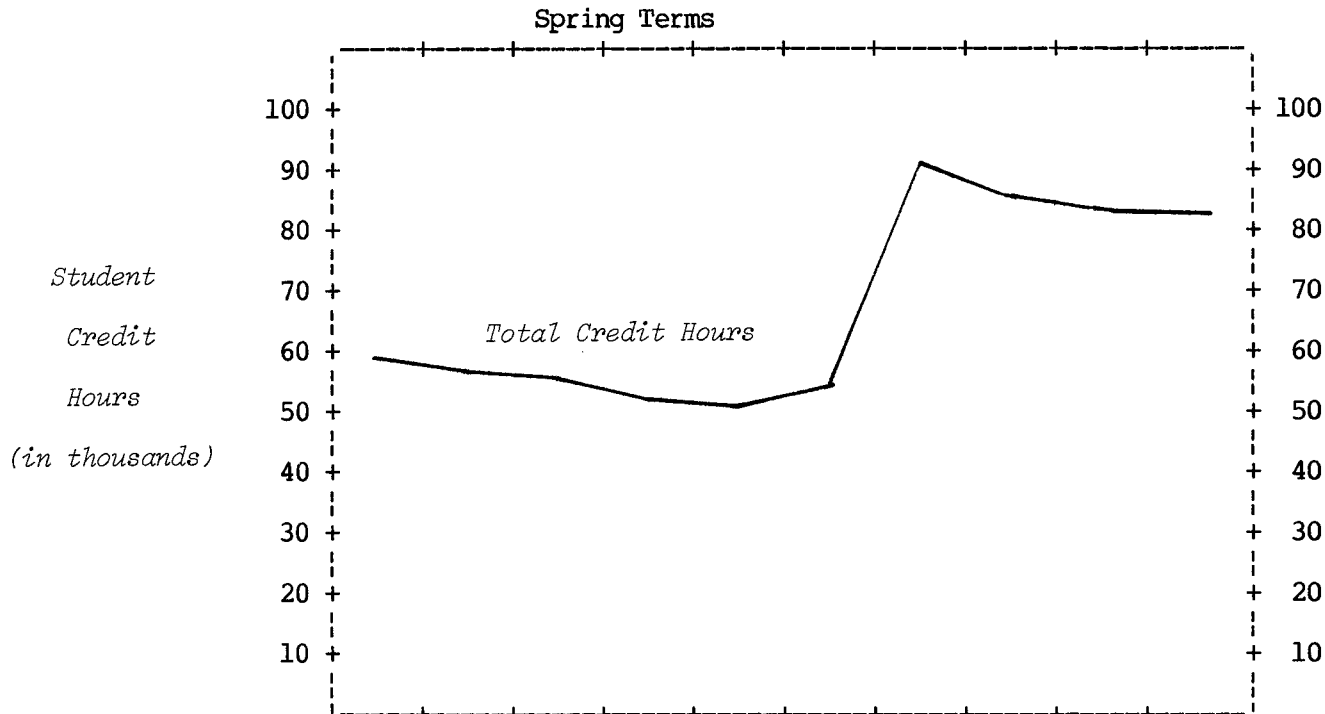
Trendgraph of Term Student Credit Hours
