The total number of students enrolled Summer Semester 1993 as of input cutoff date, August 24, 1993, was 15,122. This represents an increase of 3,336, or 28.3 %, from Summer Half-Quarter 1992.

The total number of credit hours generated by these students is 99,481, an increase of 26,421, or 36.2 %, from Summer Half-Quarter 1992.
