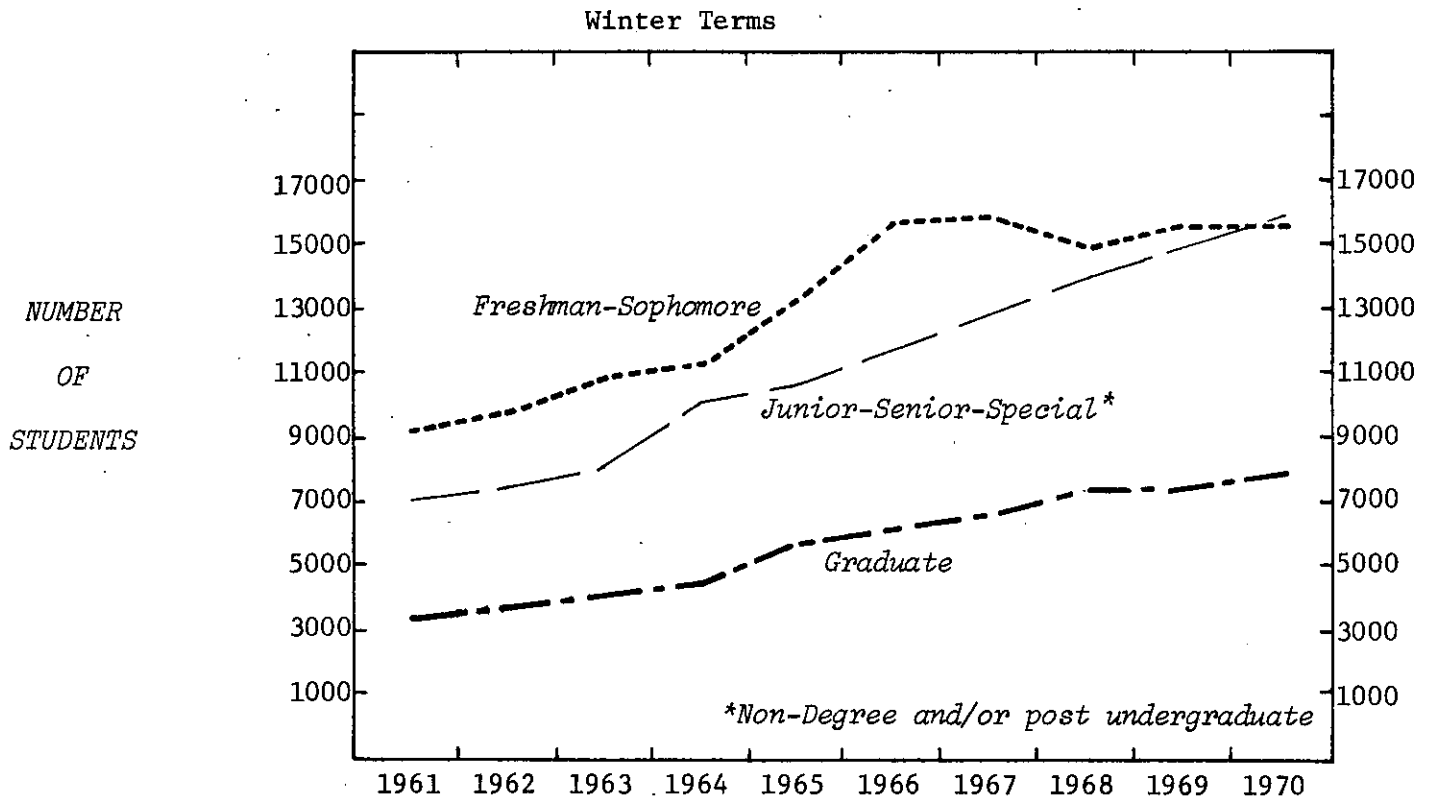

East Lansing Campus.



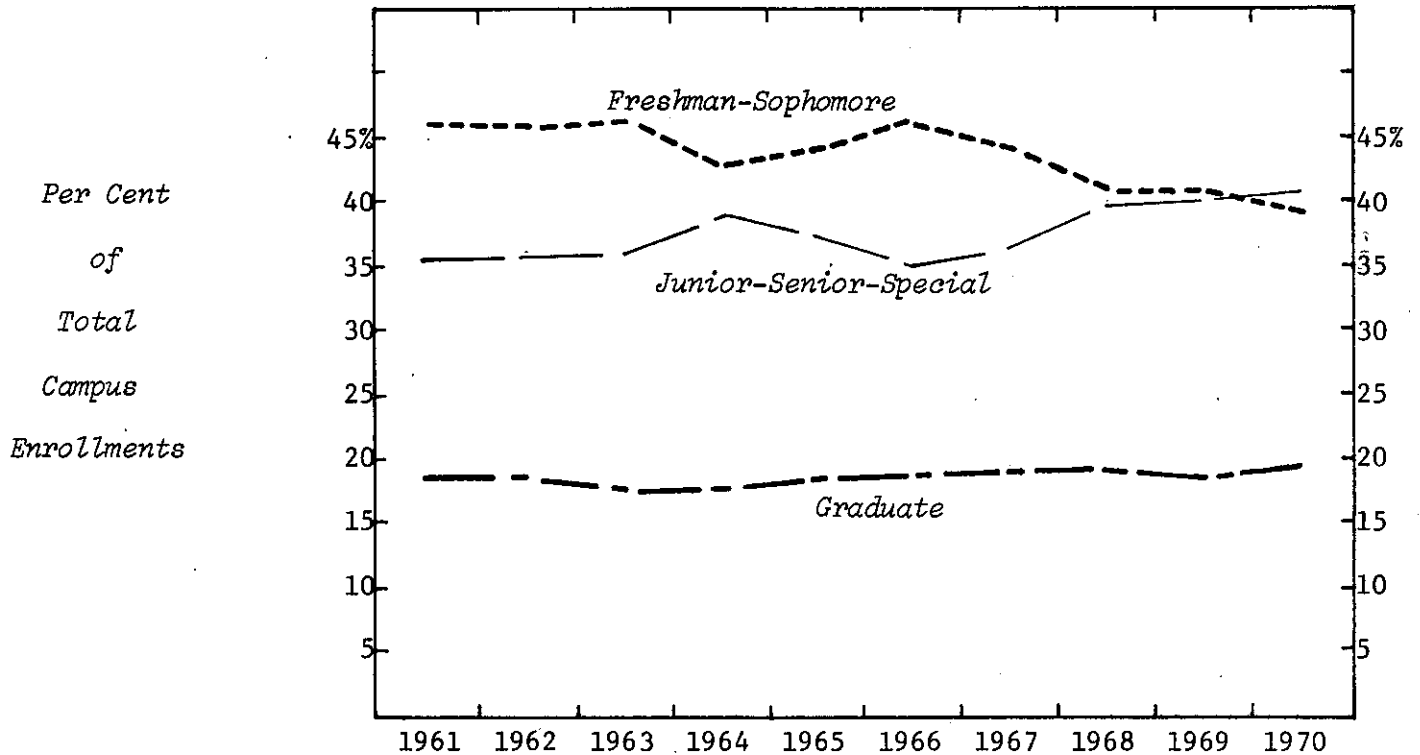
