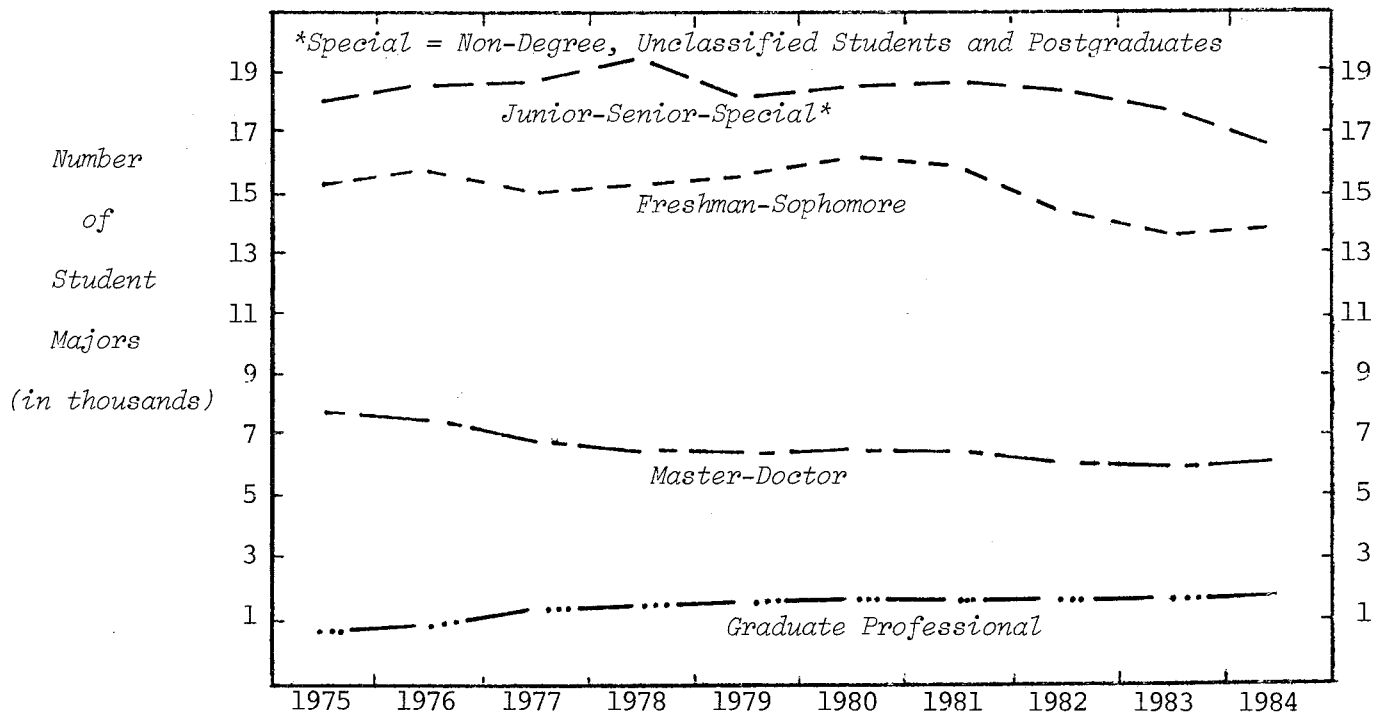

Winter Terms

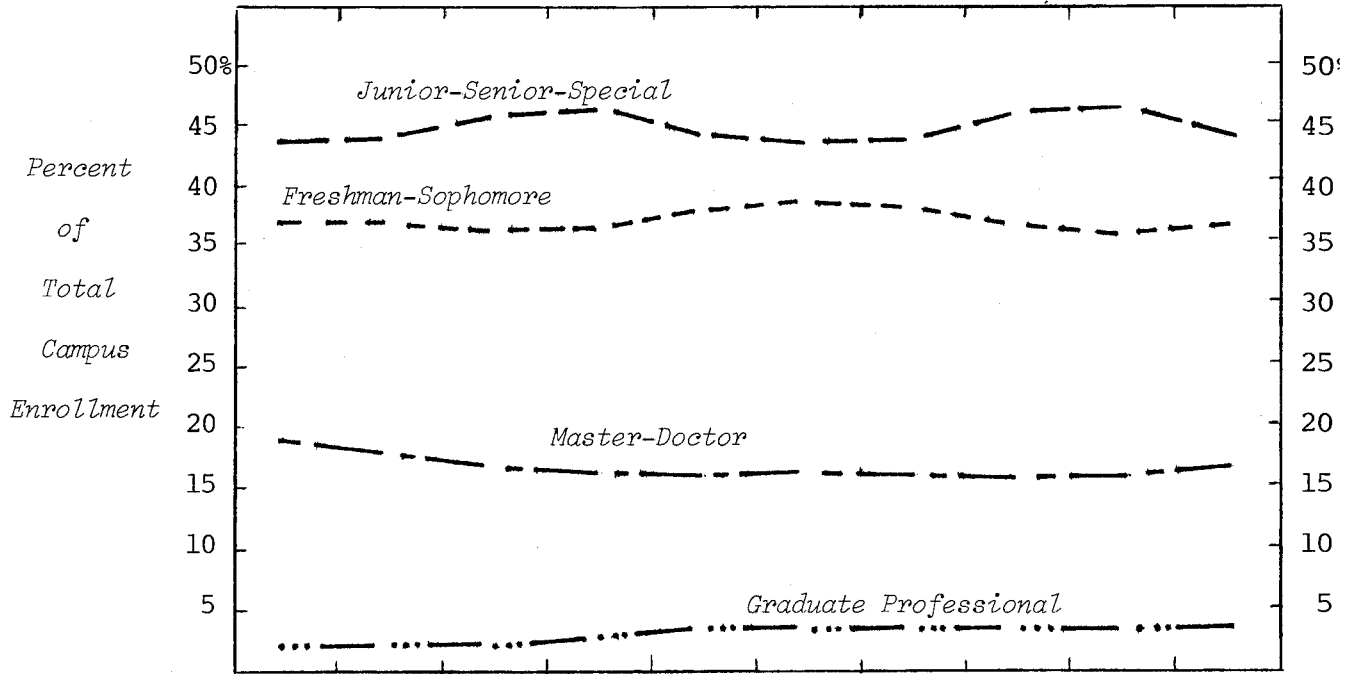

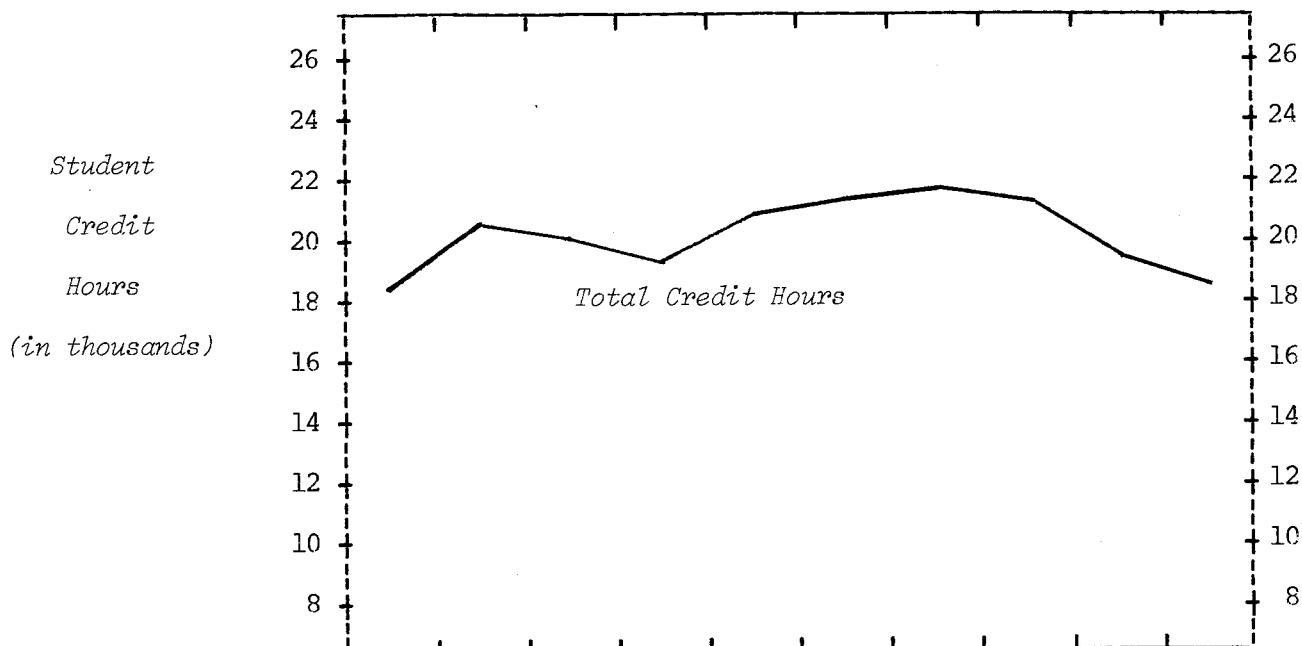

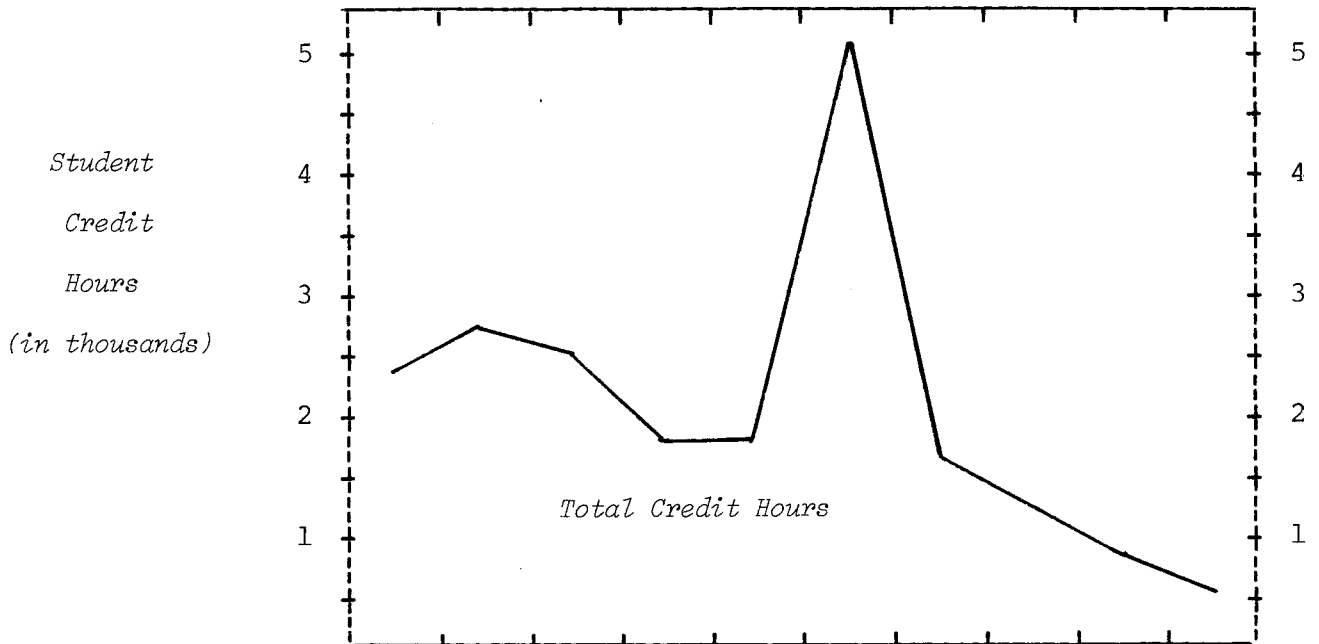
