Other academic information: Students studying at JCU must enroll in a minimum of equivalent of 12 MSU credits (9 JCU units) and a maximum of 16 MSU credits (12 JCU credits). (Students may select courses on the Townsville or Cairns campuses, however as the campuses are four hours apart, it is important all courses are taken on the same campus in a given semester. Most subjects are worth 3 to 4 units. The main campus is located in Townsville. While most subjects are offered at the Cairns and Townsville locations, students who would like to study Engineering, Marine Biology, or Education should choose the Townville campus as courses in these fields are not offered in Cairns.

JCU offers a wide range of subjects and will enroll in courses with both international and Australian students. Courses or classes are called "subjects" at JCU and most are valued at 3 units. Like other Australian universities, JCU is a three year institution. Courses are 1000, 2000 or 3000, each respectively equivalent to 200, 300 or 400 level courses at MSU. Some courses contain a field trip component, which is noted in the course description. Additional fees for the field trips apply.
