Other academic information:

Fall semester: Late September to mid-December (13 weeks total)

Spring Semester: Late January to late May (16 weeks total)

Students will be required to enroll in the equivalent of 12 MSU credits per semester at Loughry. Course offerings include (but are not limited to): Food technology, Supply management (food), Packaging, Communications, and Marketing

A level: lowest level; students can only take 2 of these courses on the first year of the Foundation Degree (FdSc)

Level 1: year 1 of BSc/FdSc

Level 2: year 2 of BSc/FdSc (students progressing from the FdSc must go into Year 2 of the BSc so they spend 2 years at Level 2)

Level 3: year 3 of BSc/FdSc
