Fall: Beginning of September until mid-December.

Spring: Beginning of February until mid-June

The University of Pecs uses the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS). Students should take 30 ECTS credits per semester, transferring as 15 MSU credits. A minimum full-time load per semester is 24 ECTS credits which will transfer as 12 MSU credits.

Assessment

The courses have their own specified assessment methods and requirements. These may include a mixture of written papers, examinations, special tests, presentations, or other practical assignments. Teaching methods vary from subject to subject, although most involve a mixture of formal lectures and smaller seminars, which provide the foundation for further independent study. The last month of each semester is the exam period.

The first cycle programs last 6-8 semesters (3-4 years, 180-240 credit points) and lead to a Bachelor's degree. The second cycle programs leading to a Master's degree, last 2-4 semesters (1-2 years, 60-120 credit points).

^{**}MSU credit conversion is based on ECTS credits. ECTS stands for European Credit Transfer System and provides a way of measuring and comparing learning achievements and transferring them from one institution to another. ECTS credits are of relative value. The ECTS credit is 50% of this US credit value: i.e., ECTS credits x ½ = MSU credits. **Grading is in a five-point system.**
