

Reporting 0.0 Grades

Veterans' education benefits are paid on the basis of enrollment and class attendance. Therefore, if a student who received veterans' benefits stops attending classes before the end of the term, Michigan State University is required to report the last date of attendance.

A student who stops attending classes without following the university withdrawal procedure may receive failing grades of 0.0 for their unofficial withdrawal. Instructors will report a last date of attendance if a student stops attending classes without completing the coursework.

In compliance with VA regulations, the last date of attendance for any class in which a failing grade is received will be determined by the university by using one or more of the following criteria:

- The last date in the instructor's record reflecting class attendance
- The last date in the instructor's record when papers were submitted
- The last date in the instructor's record when an examination was completed
- The last date in the instructor's record reflecting academic activity
- The first day of class of the semester, if no other documentation is provided
